#### About Everett, WA

Everett is the county seat and largest city in Snohomish County, Washington, located 25 miles north of Seattle. As of the 2000 census the city had a total population of 91,488, making it the 6th largest in the state and fourth-largest in the Puget Sound area. Everett is home to the second-largest marina on the west coast of the United States and Boeing's new 787 plant, the largest building in the world by volume. Snohomish County is nestled between the sparkling blue waters of
